

Locations & Directions

Women's Center Headquarters

2 West Street

Danbury, CT 06810

Services: All of our services are provided at this location, in addition to housing our administration, development, and finance departments.

Directions: We are located in the large brick building next to the Danbury Public Library in downtown Danbury. Please use our 2 West Street main entrance, with the Women's Center sign above it, where our lobby is located.

Traveling East on I-84:

- Take Exit 4 (US-6 W/US-202 W/Lake Ave)
- Turn left at the stop light onto Lake Ave Ext.
- In 1.3 miles, the Women's Center will be located on your right

Traveling West on I-84:

- Take Exit 5 (CT-53/Downtown Danbury/Bethel)
- Turn right at the stop light onto Main Street
- Continue on Main Street for a little over a mile
- At the stoplight, turn right onto West Street
- We are located just on the left once you turn onto West Street

Parking: Clients and visitors can park on the street, which is metered. Please bring quarters with you for the meters, and if you need assistance, please let us know. Parking is also available up the street at Danbury Town Hall.

Danbury Superior Court

Services: Our Family Violence Victim Advocates are housed in Danbury Superior Court. Our Family Violence Victim Advocates work closely with domestic violence and sexual assault victims by providing information about the law, the court process and other legal options available to crime victims in Connecticut.

Directions: The entrance to Danbury Superior Court is located on 146 White Street. Everyone must pass through building security on the first floor to gain access to all other levels. Metal detectors are used to scan all individuals and their belongings. Food and beverages are not permitted beyond security.

Traveling West on I-84:

- Take Exit 5 to end of exit and turn right at light on to Main Street.
- Proceed down Main Street to the fifth* light, which is the intersection of White and Main Street. Go left on to White Street. (You will see a sign on your right at that intersection noting the turn for the Court).

- Proceed down White Street through two lights.
- The Courthouse is on the right, past the railroad tracks and Leahy's Fuel.

Traveling East on I-84:

- Take Exit 5. Go through a stop sign to the bottom of hill and a traffic light.
- Go right at this light on to Main Street.
- Proceed to intersection of White and Main Streets, which is at the fourth* light and turn left on to White Street. (You will see a sign on your right at that intersection noting the turn for the Court).
- Proceed down White through two lights.
- The Courthouse is on the right, past the railroad tracks and Leahy's Fuel.

Parking: There is limited on-street, metered parking near the Courthouse. Public parking is available for a fee at the Patriot Garage, 21 Delay Street, near the train station. Handicapped and Juror parking is available onsite at 146 White Street.

Services: Our Campus Advocates provide support services to victims of domestic violence and sexual assault within the Western Connecticut State University community.

Directions: White Hall is on the corner of White St. and Fifth St. Our office is the lower basement level of White Hall.

Traveling East on I-84

- Take Exit 5 off I-84 to first traffic light (Main Street).
- Turn right and continue on Main Street to White Street (fourth traffic light).
- Turn left on White Street and continue 1/2 mile.
- The campus is on the left. Parking is available in the parking garage on the right.

Traveling West on I-84

- Take Exit 5 off I-84 to first traffic light (Clapboard Ridge Road).
- Turn right and continue on (Clapboard Ridge will turn into Main Street) to White Street (fifth traffic light).
- Turn left on White Street and continue 1/2 mile.
- The campus is on the left. Parking is available in the parking garage on the right.

Parking: A parking garage is located on Fifth St. next to White Hall.
