



Top 10 facts about the Women's Center:

- 1** We provide free and confidential services to victims of domestic violence and sexual assault, including women, men, and children.
- 2** We staff two 24-hour hotlines: One for domestic violence and one for sexual assault.
- 3** We have a 13-bed shelter, Elizabeth House, to house women and children fleeing violence in their homes. Alternate safe housing options are provided for adult male victims.
- 4** We are on call 24/7/365.
- 5** We provide on-site emergency response at local hospitals and police departments, and at court. Walk-ins are served at our 2 West Street office.
- 6** Our counseling services cover a broad range of topics such as self-esteem, ending relationships, separation and divorce, coping with stress and anxiety, and GLBT issues.
- 7** We provide free education programs for all ages—from pre-school to senior citizens. These programs are provided in schools, colleges, businesses, social and civic groups, and faith-based organizations.
- 8** We are the *only* state-certified provider of these support services in our 13-town community: Bethel, Brookfield, Kent, New Milford, Redding, Roxbury, Warren, Bridgewater, Danbury, New Fairfield, Newtown, Ridgefield, Sherman and Washington.
- 9** We serve more than 25,000 women, men, and children annually.
- 10** We rely on donations for more than half the funds needed to run the Women's Center, so we can be there for all those who turn to us for help.
