Women's Center Joins NO MORE Challenge on Crowdrise

DANBURY, March 3 - The Women's Center has joined the the NO MORE Challenge, a fundraising effort supporting organizations committed to ending domestic violence and sexual assault.

The NO MORE Challenge is an opportunity started by NO MORE, a national awareness and bystander engagement campaign for domestic violence and sexual assault, in partnership with CrowdRise to help nonprofits across the country that are working to end domestic violence and sexual assault raise much-needed funds and awareness for their work. The Women's Center is one of more than 150 participating organizations.

The Women's Center's mission is to serve the needs of individuals, families and the community with prevention, crisis intervention and support services with regard to domestic violence, sexual assault and other major life crises. Making a donation on CrowdRise or by donating your old cell phone will do a world of good for the Women's Center, supporting the vital work we do in our community.

The NO MORE Challenge kicked off on Thursday, February 4th at 12:00 p.m. ET, when domestic violence and sexual assault were spotlighted in a powerful Super Bowl PSA. The spot was released on YouTube and aired just after halftime during Super Bowl 50 on February 7th.

The team that raises the most during the Challenge wins a \$50,000 donation; second place receives \$30,000; third gets \$20,000. Weekly bonus challenges and contests enable charities to win up to another \$50,000.
